Rules and Regulations

1. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH
2. There will be no switching of entries or refunds for scratches after 8:30 A.M. the day of the show without a Veterinarian's Certificate. In case of horses or riders being entered and not exhibited, the entry fee will still be due in full and not refunded if already paid. **refund will only be made if the class is canceled.**
3. Entry Fees must be Paid in FULL before numbers are issued and entry forms must be properly signed and given to the Secretary. A returnable deposit of \$1.00 may be charged for numbers issued.
4. Every animal entered for competition shall be under the control of the Committee but neither Gardnertown Farm nor the Committee will be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur. The Committee, Gardnertown Farm or its owners and staff, employees or agents shall not be liable whatsoever for any injury to person or property of any spectator, visitor, exhibitor, groom or any person by reason of any event occurring during the show including Gross Neglect by anyone. Signatures on the Entry Form are conflict of this agreement being read and understood.
5. Every entry at the show shall constitute an agreement that the person making it shall be subject to the rules of the show and that every owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, rider and horse is eligible as entered and that the owner and/or any of his representatives are bound to accept as final the decision of the Committee on any question arising under said rules and agree to hold the show, their office directors, and employees for any action taken. The signatures on the Entry Form are conflict of this agreement.
6. The committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries accepted in any division if entries must be limited, they will be accepted on a first come first serve basis.
7. Fences used in all hunter classes will include those which simulate the obstacles found in the hunting field; wall, brush, gate, coop, natural and white post and rails, and in and out. Fences used in the jumper classes will include walls, panels, coops and gates.
8. All exhibitors must appear in proper riding attire with approved protective headgear; protective headgear must be worn at all times whenever mounted or schooling.
9. No persons are allowed in the ring except on official business.
10. Post Entries will be accepted at an additional charge of \$25.00
11. There will be no schooling except in any designated areas at times, and only horses and riders entered in the show may be schooled at any time. Entry number must be worn.
12. All dogs and other small animals must be on a leash at all times, if retrieved by staff unleashed a fee of \$10.00 will be charged for their return.
13. The committee reserves the right to decline any entries and to return entry fees before the starting of the class involved without being liable for compensation.
14. The Committee reserves the right to remove any spectator or exhibitor of their agents and representatives from the show grounds for any improper behavior, since the grounds are private property and presence is by invitation only.
15. The Committee reserves the right to combine or cancel any classes or to divide classes when entries warrant. It will require 3 entries to fill a class.
16. Lunch recess and schooling in the rings is at the discretion of the committee.
17. There will be an Office fee of \$35.00 for any or all exhibitors.
18. All exhibitors must keep custody of their numbers; they will be held responsible for all entry fees for classes where their number appears on the judge's card for that show. All Award Checks must be cashed within 60 days or they will not be honored.
19. Stabling available on a first come, first served basis. Stalls are provided under a permanent roof and are 10' x 10' vinyl with doors. No initial bedding provided. Stall Fee: \$ 0.00.
20. If jumping orders are to be used, they will be announced and posted at least one hour before the class is to begin.
21. Hunter classes to be judged on soundness and performance. Any additional specific will be noted.
22. Trophy and eight ribbons awarded in every class, unless otherwise specified.
23. Junior and Amateur Owner Hunter sections may be combined if there are less than 3 in each section.
24. Prize money will be paid by check drawn to cash and will be presented to exhibitor at the in gate, thereafter the Horse Show's responsibility terminates. The Horse Show will not stop payment or duplicate awards for any lost check.
25. As of Dec. 1, 2002, all horses must have ID no.
26. Heated viewing Area 225' x 100' Arena, Sand Footing 200' x 80' indoor schooling arena 200' x 80' Schooling Arena; Sandy Loom footing.
27. **Safety and Welfare-**
Emergency Room: St. Luke's Cornwall Hospital- 4.9 miles
Level 1 Trauma Center: Westchester Medical Center- 43 miles

2023 MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a

motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorbikes, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a

valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense.

Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties.

Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. GR is prohibited on

competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor

operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Safe Sport Statement

I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and **Gardnertown Farms ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events")**; I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the **"Agreement"**):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree to be bound and abide by the rules, regulations, and policies of USEF as published in the USEF Rule Book and on the website at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers (**"Risks"**).

EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY ACT WARNING:

CAUTION: HORSEBACK RIDING AND EQUINE ACTIVITIES CAN BE DANGEROUS. RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK.

Under the laws of most States, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (**Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"**), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature (**"Liability"**) which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

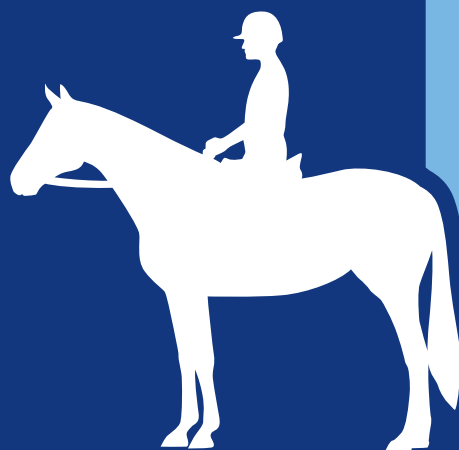
