#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CURRENT RULES OF THE USEF.
- 2. There will be no switching of entries or refunds for scratches after 8:30 A.M. the day of the show without a Veterinarians Certificate. In case of horses or riders being entered and not exhibited, the entry fee will still be due in full and not refunded if already paid. Refund will only be made If the class is canceled.
- 3. Entry Fees must be PAID IN FULL before numbers are issued and entry forms must be properly signed and given to the Secretary. A returnable deposit of \$1.00 may be charged for numbers issued.
- 4. Every animal entered for competition shall be under the control of the Committee but neither Gardnertown Farm nor the Committee will be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur. and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B.
